2	Name and Nos. Code of the Night Shelter	Night Shelter, Saraswati Educational Society Reg.-Shastri Park(Red Light).
3.	Name of NGO/Organization running the shelter	Saraswati Educational Society Reg.-Shastri Park (Red Light).
4	Number of inmates Male/Female Separately	Male-40, Female-NIL Family-NIL
5	Facility of Drinking Water	Yes! One 300 ltrs tank inside the shelter for drinking purposes and two 500 ltrs capacity tank outside the night shelter for toilets & other purposes. Water providing by the tank of DJB regularly as reported by the representative of the Society. No direct water supply.
6	Facility of toilet	Two toilets outside the shelter available.
7	Facility of Bathroom Arrangement for cleanliness status of cleanliness	No bathroom was available. One Sweeper was deputed for cleanliness, which found ok. Further some directions & suggestion were issued to the care taker at the time of visit to maintained cleanliness.
8	Details of clothing/blanket provided to inmates during night	80 blankets, 20 daries, 2 carpet & 15 gaddas were available for providing to inmates during night.
9	Whether there is provision of Kitchen or not	No kitchen was available.
10	Type of Building/Tent	Pota Cabin
11	Whether Covered/open	Covered
12	Arrangement for separation of Male/Female inmates	This night shelter is for male only as reported by representative of the organizer.
13	Lighting arrangement	Yes.

14	Any Other observation	Surrounding area of this night shelter is covered with Kabadies, who generally spread their baggage/kabad. Some directions were issued to the care taker on the spot to maintain cleanliness and to provide some equipment/article for the facility of inmates. At the time of visit 4 persons were sleeping inside the shelter, who stated that they are getting a tea and 2 rush every morning. It was noticed/informed that generally wine drinkers stay in the night shelter as one person found in drunken condition at the time of visit. It was suggested to the organizer to organize a campaign to motivate these persons to avoid alcohol to live a healthy life.
