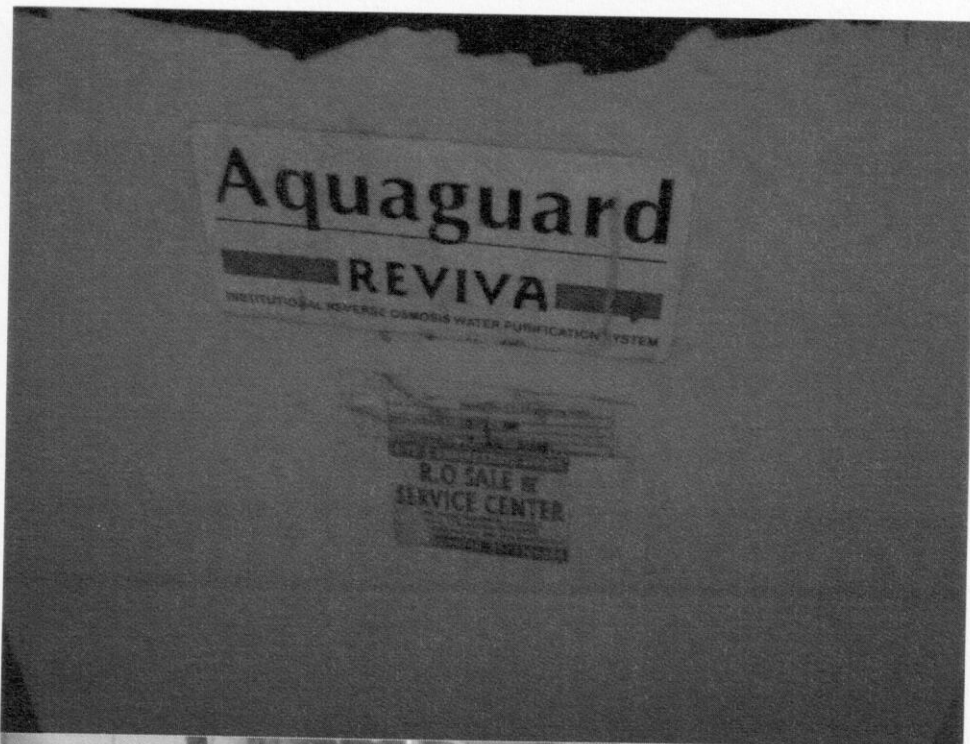

8	a Arrangement for Cleanliness	Three safai karmachari are arranged by the NGO for mantaining Cleanliness. One safai karmachri is deployed in one shift. Beside above there is one care taker.
	b Status of Cleanliness	Cleanliness were average.

9	Details of Clothing/blanket provided to inmates during night		At the time of visit there were about 190 blankets was found in the night shelter. This also includes the blankets which were already being used by the inmates.
10	Whether there is provision of kitchen or not		At the time of the visit no kitchen facilities was found in the above night shelter. The inmates stated that they have never been provided morning Tea. The supervisor Sh. Praveen assured that they will start providing morning tea and rusk from morning of 24/12/2014.
11	Type of Building/Tent		The night shelter is in the DUSIB building.

12	Arrangement for separation of Male/Female inmates		All male inmates
13	Lighting arrangement	<b>Sufficient/ insufficient</b>	At the time of visit 11 tube lights were found in working conditions out of total 16. Lighting arrangement was sufficient. The defective tube lights need to be replaced from DUSIB.
14	Security Guard		There was no Security Guard.
15	Fire fighting equipment		There were total three Fire fighting equipment (extinguishers) photo attached
16	Tank capacity for drinking/bath water		There were two water tanks on the roof. One is of capacity of 2000 litres (RCC) and one additional PVC water tank of



		capacity of 500 liters to cater to needs of drinking as well as bathing of inmates.

18	Any other observation	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Some of the inmates complained that the blankets used by them are not washed and having lice. DUSIB needs to ensure the washing of these blankets is done on appropriate intervals.</li> <li>2. Some of the window panes were found broken. These need to be repaired/refixed on priority basis by DUSIB.</li> <li>3. White washing of the building is required for making better environment and sanitary condition.</li> <li>4. In the adjoining hall of the existing night shelter, there were about 14 students and reportedly they were from Aman biradri and were staying on temporary basis. The NGO "Center for Equity Study" had given them permission upto 30/12/2014. This hall will also be taken by the "AAA". This hall will have the capacity of accommodating 80 inmates in future.</li> </ol>



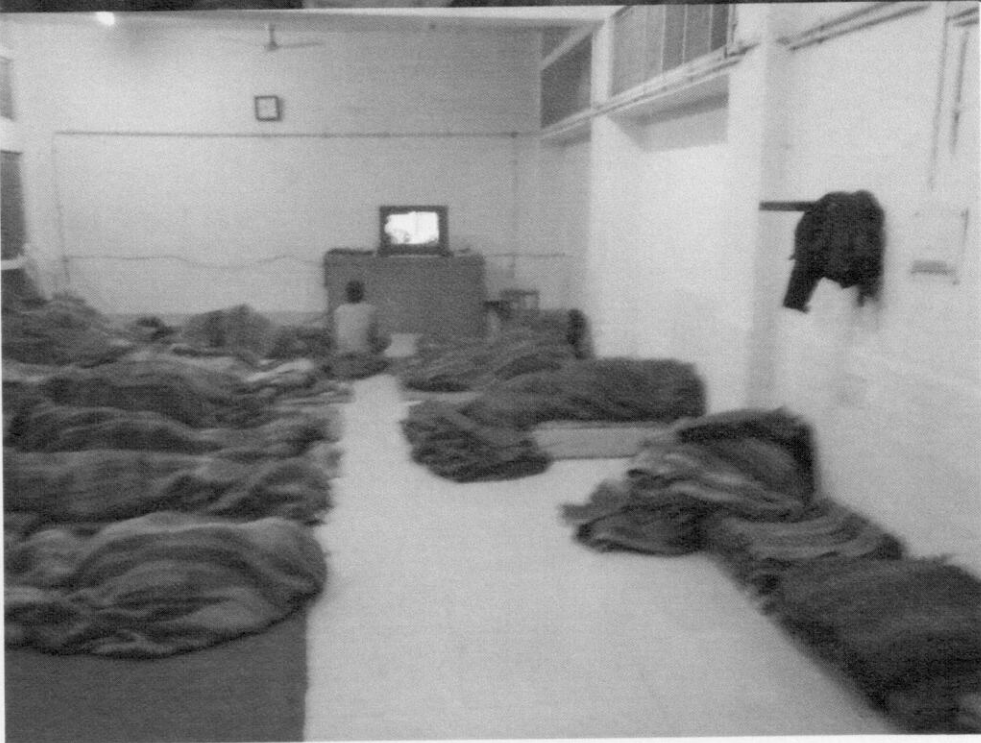
