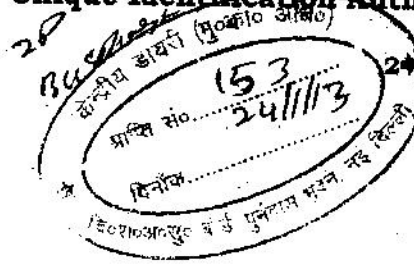

Subject: Upload of Enrolment Forms on website for Resident's use.

As you are aware enrolment form and enrolment under the aadhaar project is free of cost. Complaints have been received from residents regarding refusal of enrolments through enrolment forms downloaded from UIDAI website. It has also come to notice that limited enrolments forms are distributed on a daily basis and residents are made to wait in long queues to obtain enrolment forms or are sold.

2. In this connection, Registrars are requested to not only seek to ramp up the enrolment capacity but also to translate the enrolment form in local languages and post it on their website (both English & local language) along with the KYR+ form (wherever applicable). The form downloaded from the website should be accepted for enrolment of residents. The EAs working with you may be instructed accordingly. The EAs working with you may be instructed accordingly. This small step will go a long way in addressing the issue of forms being sold and ease the harassment & resentment of residents. A copy of latest prescribed enrolment form is enclosed for your ready reference.
