In supersession of previous orders, CEO, DUSIB has been pleased to designate all Deputy Directors of DUSIB to exercise powers under Section 41 & 42 of DUSIB Act, 2010. As per Section 41 of Delhi Urban Shelter Improvement Board, if the Board is of the opinion that any person, in occupation of any property of DUSIB is required to be evicted, the Board shall issue a notice in writing calling upon all persons concerned to show cause why an order of eviction should not be made and also ask the persons to appear before the Board on the date specified in the notice along with the evidence which they intend to produce.

- Further, as per Section 42 if after considering the show cause, the Board is satisfied that the public premises is in un-authorized occupation, the Board may make an order of eviction for reasons to be recorded therein, directing that the property shall be vacated on such date as may be specified in the order.
- The sixth meeting of Board which was held on 23.02.2012 decided that the officers of the Board shall exercise the powers under Section 41 and 42 of the Act relating to eviction of un-authorized occupants as authorized by the Chief Executive Officer.
- I, therefore, in exercise of the above powers conferred to me delegate these powers to concerned Director/Deputy Director of the Section for matters relating to eviction of unauthorized occupants and for initiating proceedings for recovery of charges, cost, expenses, fees, license fees, damage or rent etc.
- The pending cases of eviction will be disposed of by the designated Estates Officer within a period of 03 months.

All Deputy Directors will send a fortnightly report to Pr. Director to ensure timely disposal of pending cases.
