
OFFICE ORDER.

Subject: - Transfer of work and staff relating to the implementation of the Slum Clearance & Improvement Scheme and allied schemes from the Municipal Corporation of Delhi to the Delhi Development Authority.

In pursuance of the decision communicated in the Govt. of India, Ministry of Works, Housing and Supply (Department of Works & Housing) letter No. K-17011/19/71 UDIII dated the 11th February, 1974 and Secretary (LSC), Delhi Administration, New Delhi letter No. 12(4)/74-659 dated 19th February, 1974, that the work and staff relating to the implementation of the Slum Clearance and Improvement and allied schemes should be transferred from the Municipal Corporation of Delhi to the D.D.A., the staff members of schedule II presently employed in the Slums Wing who have opted for transfer to the D.D.A. alongwith the scheme and whose names are given in Annexure A; are hereby transferred to the Delhi Development Authority with effect from the forenoon of 1.3.1974 on the terms and conditions mentioned in Annexure B.

2. These officers/officials shall immediately report for duty to the Commissioner(Slums), Delhi Development Authority or any other officer authorised by Commissioner(Slums), D.D.A. in this respect.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

The Establishment of the Slum Unit will be separate. The employees of this unit alone will be considered for confirmation and promotion against the posts in this unit.

2. The terms of appointment of these employees in the M.C.D. and the emoluments drawn by them before the transfer of the scheme would be fully protected.



OFFICE ORDER-I

In pursuance of Government of India, Ministry of Works & Housing decision contained in their letter No. K-19077/9/77-DD-II dated 22.12.77 and para (ii) of this Administration two office orders of even number dated 23rd March, 1978, the Lt. Governor is pleased to order the terms and conditions of the regular employees and the daily wage employees of the Slum & JJ(Removal) Wings of MOD w.e.f. 1.1.1979 as under:-

- (i) Since the Slum Work & JJR work are Govt. of India schemes financed and controlled by them through the Delhi Administration, the staff of these two Wings will be maintained as a separate entity in the Municipal Corporation of Delhi and accordingly a separate cadre will be formed.
- (ii) This cadre will form a 4th cadre in the Municipal Corporation in addition to the existing cadres (i) General Wing, (ii) DESU and (iii) W.S. & S.D.U.
- (iii) The pays and inter-se-seniority of the staff of JJR and Slum Wings will remain as they are subject to reconsideration of individual cases on merit.
- (iv) The rate of House Rent Allowance admissible to the staff of these two wings will not exceed 15% w.e.f. 1.1.1979. There will be no other change in their salaries and allowances etc.

OFFICE ORDER

In pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Works & Housing letter No. 11011/2/80-LSG dated 28th February, 1980 the Lt. Governor of Delhi is pleased to order the transfer of Slum Clearance, Improvement and Allied Schemes and the Jhuggi Jhopri Removal Scheme from the Municipal Corporation of Delhi to the DDA w.e.f. 15.5.80. The transfer of staff of the Slum and JJR Department will be in accordance with the following directions:-

- i) The Slum Department will be maintained as a separate entity and its staff will not be merged with the DDA main staff. The services matters of the Slum Deptt. will be the concern of the Slum Estt. headed by the Director(Slum & JJ) under the overall direction and control of V.C. DDA.
- ii) Such regular staff as were transferred with the Slum Department on 1.4.78 to the MCD will now be transferred with the Slum Department to the DDA. Also such staff as have been directly recruited at the lowest and initial levels in the Slum Department after 1.4.78 will be transferred with the Slum Department to the DDA. All additional staff posted from the MCD General Wing to the Slum Deptt. will revert to the MCD before transfer of the Slum Deptt. to the DDA.
- iii) Such regular staff of the JJR Department as were transferred to MCD on 1.4.78 will now be transferred with the JJR Establishment to the DDA. This will include the regular sanitation staff transferred with the JJR Establishment vide order No. PA/D(P)/78/30-N dated 31.3.78. All such regular staff will form part of a common cadre of the DDA. Also such staff as have been directly recruited in the JJR Establishment after 1.4.78 will stand transferred with JJR Establishment to the DDA and their inter-se-seniority determined in the relevant category of the DDA as per rules. Such persons as are on deputation with the JJR Establishment will revert to their parent establishments before transfer of JJR Establishment to the DDA.
- (iv) Such work-Charged and daily wage staff as were transferred by the Engineering and Horticulture Department of the DDA alongwith Slum and JJR Establishment on 1.4.78, and are still in the service of these two departments, will be transferred alongwith their relevant establishments to the DDA. The responsibility for ensuring such transfer will be that of Chief Engineer, DDA and Director(Hort.), DDA who will for the purpose consult the concerned Accounts Officers of the Slums and JJR Estt. with regard to the precise number of such staff transferred on 1.4.78 to the MCD.
- (v) All the assets and liabilities of the Slum and JJR Scheme as on 15.5.80 will stand transferred to the DDA and the concerned departments of the DDA and the MCD will prepare inventories of assets and liabilities jointly, and the decision of the Lt. Governor of Delhi will be final with regard to any disputes that may arise.

The order of transfer of the Slum and JJR Establishment will also take effect from 15.5.80.

I am directed to say that the Implementation of the Slum Wing in Delhi was transferred from Municipal Corporation of Delhi to Delhi Development Authority vide this Ministry's letter No.11011/2/80-LSC dated the 28th February, 1980. The question of retransfer of the Slum Wing to the Municipal Corporation of Delhi has however been under consideration of the Government of India for some time.

2. After careful consideration it has now been decided that the work relating to the Slum Wing in Delhi should be retransferred from the Delhi Development Authority to Municipal Corporation of Delhi with effect from 1st September, 1992.

3. I am accordingly directed to request that the Lt. Governor may take steps for the smooth transfer of the Slum Wing from the Delhi Development Authority to the Municipal Corporation of Delhi, including preparation of a statement of assets and liabilities created under the Slum Wing and settlement of these and connected matters.

4. The transfer is to be on an as-is-where-is basis.

Subject: Transfer of Slum & JJ Wings of Delhi Development Authority (DDA) to the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD).

In pursuance of Government of India Ministry of Urban Development letter No.K.20014/4/91-DDVA IIB dated 26th August, 1992 regarding the transfer of Slum & JJ Wings of the Delhi Development Authority (DDA) to the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD), it is hereby ordered further as under:-

- (a) The transfer will be effective from 1.9.1992
- (b) The transfer will be on "as is where is" basis.
- (c) On transfer to the MCD, the Slum & JJ Wings of the DDA will be known as "The Slum & JJ Department of MCD".
- (d) Except to the extent indicated below, working of the Slum & JJ Department will be governed by the same rules of business and procedure as are applicable to any other Department of the MCD.
- (e) The Slum & JJ Department of the MCD will be maintained as a separate entity with its own staff, accounts, stores, etc. till orders are issued to the contrary.
- (f) All the assets and liabilities of the Slum & JJ Wing of the DDA including all lands in JJR colonies will be deemed to have been transferred to the Slum & JJ Department of the MCD with effect from 1.9.1992.
- (g) The employees of the Slum & JJ Wing of the DDA will become the employees of Slum & JJ Department of the MCD. They will continue to be governed by their present terms and conditions of service. They will not be merged with any cadres of the MCD till any orders to the contrary are issued.

- (h) The employees of the DDA who are presently posted to the Slum & JJ Wing of the DDA will continue to work as part of Slum & JJ Department of the MCD till further orders. They will continue to be governed by their present terms and conditions of service. They will also continue to be members of the cadres of DDA of which they form part.
- (i) Employees of other Departments and Organisations who are on deputation to Slum & JJ Wings of DDA will be treated as on deputation with the Slum & JJ Department of MCD on the existing terms and conditions.
