

"Har Ghar Tiranga" : Action Points

Hon'ble Union Home Minister and Hon'ble Union Minister of Culture on 17.07.2022 held a meeting with all the Lieutenant Governors and Administrators of Union Territories and Chief Ministers to review the preparations for the "Har Ghar Tiranga" campaign launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister to celebrate "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsava" (AKAM).

Under this campaign, the Tricolor is proposed to be hoisted atop more than 20 crore houses as well as govt. and private institutions/establishments across the country from August 13th to 15th, 2022 through public participation.

Accordingly, as desired by the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, it is requested that immediate necessary action may be undertaken on the following:

The Color to be hoisted on all the Govt. buildings, public places & important locations from the 13th, August-15th, August.

ii. Concerted efforts to be made by all Departments of GNCTD, MCD, NDMC, DDA & Delhi Police for popularizing the "Har Ghar Tiranga" initiative for ensuring maximum Jan Bhagidari to make the programme a grand success. A special Information, Education and Communication (IEC) Campaign to be launched from 22nd, July for public sensitisation and awareness.

iii. Social media may be used for popularizing the campaign. Pictures of the campaign to be uploaded on the portal "https://harghartiranga.com"

For the success of the campaign the requirement of flags and their procurement may be planned well in advance. The citizens may be encouraged to purchase the flags.

v. The departments may procure the flags either through the registered vendors on the GeM Portal or through Self Help Groups (SHGs)/Other manufacturers /suppliers. Alternatively, the Ministry of Culture can also be approached to procure a specified number of flags at prescribed rates and the requirements must be indicated to the Ministry latest by 20th, July. Simultaneously appropriate accounting procedure may be devised so that realisation from sale proceeds of the flags sourced through the producers.

From July 22nd, the national flag to appear on the homepage of all the websites of the various Govt. departments & undertakings.

vii. "Prabhat Pheris" by school students to be organized from 11th, August to 14th, August.

viii. An Action Plan on the above may kindly be shared for perusal of Hon'ble LG before 22nd July 2022. It may be ensured that all actions may be taken as per the Flag Code.
