Sir/Ma'am,

As you may be aware, Government of India has undertaken several initiatives aimed at enhancing Ease of Doing Business and Ease of Living for citizens and, in furtherance to this, the DPIIT has requested all the States & UTs to carry out a de-novo analysis for all compliances. The compliances would be examined as under:

- o Analysis of all the forms/ approvals/ inspections/ renewals
 - o Simplification of all the forms
 - o Analysis of best practices which can be adopted by the departments
 - o Conducting the Stakeholder consultation to understand the problems of units /establishments

All the concerned departments are requested to carry-out de-novo analysis for all compliances and scrutinize all Acts/ Rules/ regulations in light of the principles laid down for the decriminalization as per the Jan Vishwas (Amendment of Provisions) Bill 2022 for further submission to the DPIIT in a timely manner. For conducting this exercise, Department of Industries, GNCTD has prepared toolkits attached at Annexures I and II (**Business-Related Toolkit and Citizen-Related Toolkit**) for data collection. The Department of Industries shall analyse the responses received from the departments and share recommendations which may be carried out by the stakeholder departments.

All the departments are requested to accord the subject on top priority and share the information at the earliest by 5th July 2023.
